Please be as precise as possible.	The proposal is on Green Belt land and is accessible to the general public. Brownfield sites should be used first - there are numerous and extensive undeveloped brownfield sites in Rochdale, and these are closer to public transport. Adding up to 1,000 more cars will mean more pollution and increase the delays already experienced, aggravating pollution further. There is no direct access to motorways from the proposed site north of the River Roche - just 3 road bridges all in already congested built-up areas. Local and varied wildlife will be affected by the destruction of its natural habitat. Green-field based sports activities are vital to community health and should be protected. High voltage overhead electricity networks cross the site; I have grave concerns over the impact on public health in its immediate proximity.
