The Foundational Economy Innovation fund is providing grants for businesses and organisations working in Greater Manchester's foundational economy - including the health and social care, early education and childcare, and the local high street (retail, hospitality, culture, leisure and tourism) sectors - to trial new ideas and become more resilient. Initial grants of up to £11,000 are available.
