There are many more areas in Wigan that would be more appropriate than Lowton.. There is one substantial infrastructure project that could change the out come of of more building in Lowton. That is to extend the Atherleigh bypass across the A 580 towards Winnick lane this would reduce congestion at the major road junction of lane head by 60%. The additional road alterations the Golborne junction A573with A580 ie traffic light control

More and wider traffic lanes to all entrances and exits.

Finally is proposed that 75 properties would be built with access solely from Rowan avenue this plan is without merit because the narrow road into this estate would make

a-dangerous junction with the main A572 putting lives at risk, also parking in this area

makes it difficult to navigate already.
