As local resident I find the current infrastructure unable to cope with the demands of the people who live here currently.
We lost bus services when the Guided Busway was built which has led to people not being able to get on a bus as they fill up on the way from Leigh. Using the busway as a selling point for these new houses is misleading and will only put more pressure on an already struggling service.
