It is far from consistent with sustainable development and NPPF Chapters.
	Having worked in the car industry I am very aware of the negative impact on air quality of diesel particulates and nitrogen oxide. It is estimated that up to 20,000 deaths a year are caused in this country by car pollution. I reference the well publicised coroners report of Ella Kissi-Deborah"s death in 2013 confirming the deadly impact of car pollution, including severe asthma attacks. Building these executive houses away from tram and railway stations will add 1000+ cars onto busy roads increasing airborne pollution with its negative health impacts especially for Children. This is not sustainable.
	Quite frankly the flooding assessment is a fiction. I regularly walk across the fields and footpaths in this green belt. Heavy rain causes the area to be very boggy. The removal of trees and hedges to be replaced by houses will only increase the flood risk. Finally, schools, dental surgeries and Doctors are already full.
