Please be as precise as possible.	<p>Mort Lane and Mosley Common is already struggling with heavily congested roads and building a further 1,100 houses will only add to the volume of traffic which is a major concern as currently these roads are at a standstill during the morning and evening rush-hours. With this number of new homes, extra amenities would be needed such as GP surgeries and schools.</p> <p>The guided bus is not an alternative to easing the current congestion as passengers are already forced to wait for 3/4 passing full buses before one is available. Altering the junction onto the A580 or adding another bus stop will certainly not be a solution to easing the volume of extra cars.</p> <p>Greenbelt land and green spaces in our immediate vicinity is precious and building more homes which will increase the volume of cars will impact with higher levels of air pollution and subsequently impact on poorer health for our community.</p> <p>I have lived off REDACTED TEXT for over 20 years and this road is busy with local businesses which use HGV lorries. Local residents have been campaigning for years for speed cameras to be installed on Mort Lane, which recently has resulted in traffic calming "dragons teeth". During the last 36 months there has been 6 accidents of which 2 were serious and 1 fatal. Building more homes within this already compacted area is entirely inappropriate and potentially harmful to the area as a whole.</p>
