The extra homes will bring extra cars which the current infrastructure cannot absorb.</p> <p>It will additionally impact on the A580 junction at Mosley Common which is already operating well over capacity.</p> <p>The 1100 extra households will adversely impact the already overstretched facilities around Mosley Common, impacting GP surgeries, dentists, schools and shops.</p>
