Please be as precise as possible.	<p>I was born in the M28 area and have lived here all my life (57 years). I have seen the whole Worsley, Boothstown , Ellenbrook, and Mosley Common area totally decline in relation to quality of life and being a "good " place to live.</p> <p>The traffic in this area is horrendous and there has to be some of the worst gridlocked A roads in the country within the M28 postcode. Just last week I had to attend a 0920 hours appointment at Salford Royal and knew that the 4.5 mile journey would take me in excess of 45 minutes. I opted to travel on my bicycle to ensure I arrived on time. A simple trip to the shops can often take excessive amounts of time and becomes frustrating.</p> <p>This week, despite not really being able to afford to do so, I have had to visit a private dentist as I cannot get the services of an NHS dentist in my area. This cost me over £500. Primary school places are at a premium and I feel sorry for parents who have no option but to drive children to and from school. Children are often late through no fault of the parent and teachers are having to start their journeys 30 minutes earlier than they did some 5 years previous. I have always been proud of the Worsley area but for the first time in my life, I am seriously considering a move to a different part of the country. In summary, this plan cannot go ahead. I am fully aware of the need for housing but the whole M28 area is an absolute joke with regard to major traffic issues and providing services for tax payers. Being on the border of Salford and Wigan catchment areas comes with a whole host of issues and neither council seems to want to work together to consider the needs of existing and long term residents.</p>
