The report refers to the now defunct GMSF. There is now a labour shortage and it appears that the need for warehousing will be somewhat diminished. In addition, more and more business are using robots, yet the supporting documentation does not take this into account, if this was to happen there would be no employment benefits for the region"s people as proposed in the supporting documentation.</p> <p>Clean Air cameras are also proposed for the region, this factor does not appear to have been considered in the supporting documentation on how it will affect prospective businesses coming to the area.</p> <p>There is also no summary on how much carbon these plans will produce both during the development stage and operational stage.</p>

In addition this should take into account the current economic conditions and revised growth predictions and how the current labour shortage affects these plans. Also, the supporting documentation should consider the impact if robots were to be used in the warehouses on the proposed site.</p> <p>Also Bolton council will need to justify the introduction of Clean Air cameras whilst also attempting to attract new businesses to the area, as these two aims appear to conflict with each other.</p> <p>Furthermore, these plans should contain a summary of how much carbon will be produced in both the development stage and the operational stage.</p>
