	Traffic
	Fails to comply with PfE objective 7 and is not consistent with adapting to climate change, a zero carbon economy and NPPF chapters 2 paragraphs 8 & 9. There is no access to rail or tram within walking distance. Buses are infrequent and therefore the vast majority of journeys will require a car. There are two large primary schools close to the main road with an air quality management zone which will get worse if this goes ahead. The existing roads are already congested & other small residential streets are likely to become rat runs as traffic tries to reach Bury or Norden road. The latter is already congested at peak times. 450 houses with many two car households means @ 700 extra vehicles .
