Planning permission has been given on a very subjective idea that possible jobs created outweigh the environmental impact. The plan acknowledges that the environmental impact will be huge, but then dismisses this without any strong, objective reason.</p> <p>We are now returning to pre-pandemic traffic conditions in Wigan - congestion and pollution. The proposed development can only make this worse. It cannot be possible for this development to not have an adverse effect on the motorway and surrounding roads. There is no agreement to make Junction 25 an all-ways junction - this is extremely unlikely to happen.</p> <p>There has been very strong local objection to this development for years now. It really feels that the local people have not been listened to by Wigan Council, they just seem determined to plough ahead with it, no matter what the consequences for the people who actually live here.</p> <p>The coronavirus pandemic has shone a light on the huge importance of green open space - our Greenbelt - for everyone's physical health, mental health and wellbeing. This must now be taken into account, and the destruction of our environment stopped. Planting some trees in another part of Wigan cannot mitigate the damage done at this site.</p> |
