We are then left waiting for the bin men to decide to come back. The bins are left on the road and as we only get them amptied every 2 or 2 weeks now magne they are

and as we only get them emptied every 2 or 3 weeks now means they are left for another week leading to cats or rats eating out of the bins leaving rubbish on the pavements which leads to more rubbish removing for the
