Following recent developments in the directly surrounding area of 350+ houses on Burgess farm and 400 on Hazlehurst farm the local road network, public transport capacity and local infrastructure is already overburdened. With the end of Covid restrictions and the return to work by many traffic has already brought the major arterial roads such as the A580, A575 and A572 to a standstill every morning. The addition of 1100 homes with 1-2 cars each will add, conservatively, 1500 more cars to that problem. Buses into Manchester area already full from stops near Moseley Common, adding 1100 homes and 1000s more people will simply push the stop where buses are no longer viable further back out of Manchester, along the East Lancs/A580 towards Leigh/Wigan. It will also vastly increase the emissions from cars and impact local air quality as well as removing a vast area of green belt land currently enjoyed by residents. Wigan Council identified brownfield land that could accommodate over 8800 new homes in 2020. Other than profit, what is the justification for building on greenfield land whilst there is still an abundance of brownfield land available?
