Local people haven't been universally informed of these plans and will be deprived of their access to rural land. Future drops in population numbers haven't been considered. Information on brownfield sites as suitable alternatives to building on the Green Belt are not shown. Traffic congestion on Ridgeway Road is already desperate and will only deteriorate with this development causing more pollution. This has been ignored. No consideration has been given to expansion of other regional airports and their economies as an alternative to constantly expanding that of Manchester. There is no mention of reviews within five years as facts change.

Release the Green Belt for the reasons it was created: to prevent urban sprawl and allow local people to continue to witness green fields, wildflowers and wildlife. The proposed 'nature park' is at a distance from this location. If it has to go ahead, an exit route from the field must flow in a different direction, ie Clay Lane, to avoid air pollution increasing as vehicles stack up on Ridgeway Road. Find alternative brownfield sites on which to build. Constantly review the plans according to the needs of the community and other regions that might benefit.
