	The use of greenbelt land should legally only be done so when exceptional circumstances have been met. I do not believe this has been done due to sufficient brownfield land being available, and the number of proposed houses exceeding the demand.
	The lack of proposed new facilities would overburden the already overstretched schools, doctors, dentists. An extension to a single primary school and funding to a single secondary school is at best a token gesture which would not meet the additional demand generated by 1,100 new houses.
	The traffic in the surrounding area is already extremely busy, with regular traffic jams 7 days a week. The roads cannot cope with the current volume and and size of large vehicles using the roads. Adding in excess of 1,300 more cars every morning to the already over capacity roads shows a complete lack of care or concern to anyone living in this area.
	The proposed main access road along Wellington Drive would turn what is currently a quiet country lane in to busy highway filled with construction vehicles. This is totally unacceptable for the children that play on this street and many people of the surrounding areas who use this as a route to walk their dogs.
	The impact to the health of residents nearby has not been considered. The dust and pollution that would be created is not acceptable and would

endanger the health of those living nearby.

The impact to local wildlife has not been considered. The greenland is home to a hugely diverse range of animals. Destroying their habitat when brownfield land is available is irresponsible and damaging for future generations.
