The chair of the Neighbourhood Watch Association has requested that the Deputy Mayor considers contributing funding towards the event so that the delegates can have some lunch and refreshments (approx. £1000).

The Deputy Mayor and Chair of the Police and Crime Panel have agreed to jointly contribute a **total of £600** towards the cost of refreshments at the event. This is to be paid in time for the event as a one off payment in 2018/19.

The reasons for the decision are:


The purpose of the event is to promote Neighbourhood Watch throughout Greater Manchester and to cascade relevant information to members and, ultimately, their communities.
