
YOUTH COMBINED AUTHORITY MINUTES: January 2019

- ⇒ Combines transport and free/reduced entry to cultural, sporting and leisure attractions.

The YCA will take a key role in developing the Opportunity Pass, including the opportunity benefits, designing the card, and recommending what should happen if people mis-use the Pass.


