Foundational Economy Innovation Fund

Greater Manchester Combined Authority (GMCA)'s new Foundational Economy Innovation Fund will provide grants for businesses and organisations Greater Manchester's foundational or everyday economy to trial innovative new ideas and improve ways of working.

Background

The "everyday economy" or "foundational economy" refers to the parts of the economy people depend on for their daily needs, including adult social care, early education, childcare, retail, and leisure and hospitality, across the private, public and voluntary sectors. Many of these businesses were among the hardest hit by the pandemic and impacts of leaving the European Union and are now facing further pressure due to rising inflation and energy costs.

In Greater Manchester, about 40 per cent of the workforce are employed in the foundational economy. To become a more prosperous city-region, we want to increase resilience and potential to grow profits in these sectors by directing investment to find new, innovative ways of working.

How will it work?

Businesses and organisations are being asked to come forward as part of an initial expression of interest phase, which aims to develop networks and "match" potential applicants with relevant partners. This could involve connecting an innovator with a suitable business or matching a business with a good idea to the relevant expertise. There is also interest in taking technologies that work in other industries and applying them to foundational economy sectors.

After the initial expression of interest phase, 40 projects will be chosen to receive a £10,000 grant in the fund's first stage. A second stage will provide 10 of those projects with £60,000 to further develop their ideas, with each funding recipient also receiving support and advice.

What are we looking for?

Ideas should focus on one of four sectors: health and social care, early education and childcare, retail, or hospitality, leisure and tourism. Within those sectors, we are interested in ideas that respond to at least one of four areas where ideas could make an impact:

Keeping it local – Innovations that support local and sustainable supply chains within Greater Manchester, helping to create a regional economy that is more resilient to external shocks.

Greener, cheaper and more resilient – Innovations that reduce or manage energy consumption and costs for businesses, helping to decrease carbon emissions.

New ways of working – Innovations that help create or integrate new ways of delivering a high quality service for both workers and customers, including the adoption or development of technology.

Supporting the workforce – Innovations that help with the recruitment and retention of staff, including new ways of delivering in work training, upskilling the workforce, and engaging with freelancers and the self-employed.

Key Messages

- The Foundational Economy Innovation
 Fund aims to improve jobs, pay, and
 investment in the parts of Greater
 Manchester's "foundational economy" or
 "everyday economy" the businesses and
 organisations that provide the majority of
 jobs, goods, and services we all depend
 on.
- This includes the adult social care, early education and childcare, retail and hospitality and leisure sectors. Greater Manchester wants to work with these sectors to find the best ways to support them to grow and thrive.
- The Foundational Economy Innovation Fund will provide small grants for organisations to create local experimental projects over a 24-month period, with the aim of creating new ways of supporting these sectors. This will help reduce

- economic inequality, accelerate the recovery from Covid, and ease the impacts of Brexit.
- This fund is one aspect of support available to businesses during this time and is designed to offer applicants the chance to try out and test innovative solutions.
- Projects should address specific "opportunities": we're looking for innovations that help find better or more effective ways of delivering services, including adopting new technologies, or improve the recruitment, retention, and the training of staff. Projects could also help organisations reach net zero or localise supply chains.
- People who set up and run businesses in the foundational economy have historically struggled to attract investment – something the fund will help address. These sectors are typically seen as mundane or less glamorous than other industries. Investors looking for high returns tend to look elsewhere.
- The large number of people employed in these sectors means improving investment and jobs improves the quality of life of a large proportion of Greater Manchester's population. The Foundational Economy workforce also contains larger numbers of female workers and people experiencing racial inequalities.
- By helping businesses innovate
 we're recognising the full value of the
 Foundational Economy, making it a
 source of pride rather than being seen as
 mundane and 'low value'.
- Helping these sectors aligns with the aims of the Greater Manchester Economic Vision – on driving innovation large in all sectors, and achieving an economic recovery "that puts people first, embraces the benefits of diversity, rebalances inequalities, creates lasting resilience, supports the move to net zero carbon and rethinks productivity"



Campaign Materials and Promotion
