GMCA Addendum to paragraph 5.50 of Operation Augusta: An independent Assurance Review

Paragraph 5.50 of the report states:

5.50. On 22 April, the SIO attended a meeting with Detective Chief Superintendent A and Chief Superintendent A. According to the SIO policy log, Chief Superintendent A stated he was unable to put permanent staff into Operation Augusta and that the operation would finish on 1 July 2005.

The exact wording in the Superintendent A, the SIO's policy log entry was:

Detective Superintendent A attended a command meeting with Detective Chief Superintendent A and Chief Superintendent A. Chief Superintendent A stated that he would be unable to put permanent staff into operation but agreed to continue to provide resources until the 1/7/05. Therefore, the operation will finish on the 1/7/05.

GMCA Addendum to Appendix D Appendix D of the 14th January 2020 Operation Augusta report sets out the authors' chronology of key events. For the date 22nd April, 2005 the following paragraph is set out:

Chief Superintendent A stated he was unable to put permanent staff into Operation Augusta and that the operation would finish on 1 July 2005.

The source for this key event was Entry 70 the SIO policy book 2 (names redacted) which states:

Detective Superintendent A attended a command meeting with Detective Chief Superintendent A and Chief Superintendent A. Chief Superintendent A stated that he would be unable to put permanent staff into operation but agreed to continue to provide resources until the 1/7/05. Therefore, the operation will finish on the 1/7/05.

Names of officers have been redacted in line with approach taken to the original report.
